About Uzbekistan

Uzbekistan is a central Asian country and used to be a part of Soviet Republic. Uzbekistan is known for its wonderful Islamic architecture, most of the buildings that you see would be mosques, mausoleums and other sites connected to the Silk Road. The capital city of Uzbekistan is Tashkent. It lies between the rivers Syr Darya and Amu Darya. Uzbekistan shares its boarders with Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, and Tajikistan. Total population of the country is 34,860,000.

Climate

Uzbekistan has hot and arid climate with occasional rainfalls in winter and spring. Average temperature in Uzbekistan is about 32 degrees Celsius; however it could get to a maximum of 40 degrees Celsius in Tashkent among other cities in the day time. Since Uzbekistan is an extremely hot and might give an impression of a wasteland, houses are constructed in such a way that the windows face away from the sun.

Language

Uzbekistan population includes people from different countries in Central Asia. Hence; people in Uzbekistan mostly speak Uzbek, Tajik and Russian.

About Tashkent City

Tashkent is the capital city of Uzbekistan and it is the largest city in Central Asia. The word Tashkent means "stone village" in Uzbek and it is the center of trade and handicrafts in Uzbekistan. It is situated in an industrially developed part of Uzbekistan. There are many of the iconic places in Uzbekistan that are situated in Tashkent. A majestic domed museum with 14th-century artifacts, it will be one of a kind experience to see these ancient artifacts preserved.




Tashkent Television Tower

About Tashkent Medical Academy

Tashkent Medical Academy started as a faculty of Medicine under Turkestan State University in the year 1919. In 1931 it became Tashkent State Medical University. It was divided into two sections in the year 1990 and later it transformed into Tashkent Medical Academy in 2005. Although it is based in Tashkent, capital city of Uzbekistan, it has other campuses in Uzbekistan. There are three campuses, one in Urgench which was founded in the year 1992, one in Ferghana which was founded in 1998 and the last one in Termez which was founded in the year 2018. Institution in Termez was founded for the sole purpose of training medical professionals meeting all the modern requirements and to enhance technology in the field of medicine.

Facts about Tashkent Medical Academy

- •Currently, there are 803 faculties, 3 academicians and 97 professors working in the academy.
- •There are 4 major faculties at the academy: General Medicine, medico-pedagogical and medico prophylactic and higher nursing
- ·Presently, there are 4662 students enrolled for courses at the academy.
- •There is a main research unit focused on the scientific activities of the Academy which is called Central Research Laboratory (CRL)
- •There are 25 research projects going on at the academy.
- •There are 7 specialized scientific councils functioning in the academy.

- •Tashkent Medical Academy is in the World directory of Medical Schools maintained by World Health Organization (WHO)
- ·Approved by FAIMER and ECFMG
- ·First medical academy that became a full-featured member of Association of European Medical Schools.

Student Housing

There are 5 student housing dormitories which are available for students. There are a total of 1740 beds in these dormitories in which 1720 students are already accommodated. Each student house has the following:

- ·Spiritual room, a kitchen, a computer room and library
- •Each residence have a Wi-Fi zone for students to access internet at all times
- •There are drawing, sewing, art, computer literacy and foreign language classes for students to join
- ·For leisure and extracurricular activities, each residence has a gym, football field, volleyball, and basketball courts

How to Apply?

Eligibility criteria

Students must take National Eligibility and Entrance Examination (NEET)

Documents Required

- ·An application addressed to the rector of the Institute
- ·Contact information of the student and the parents
- ·10th standard mark lists and certificate
- ·12th Standard Mark lists and certificate
- ·6 passport size photographs
- ·Copy of your valid passport

How to apply?

Step 1: Online Application

Fill an online application in the TMA website

Step 2: Documents

Submit the filled application along with all the documents mentioned above

Step 3: Application Review

Wait for the university to review your application

Step 4: Confirmation Letter

If your application is selected, university will send you an offer letter

Step 5: Pay your fee

Once you receive your fee confirmation letter, you will have to make your first year tuition fee payment to confirm your position at the university.

Step 6: Visa application

By this stage of your application process, you will have all your documents to apply for your visa. Fill in the online application and form send all the documents you have for the embassy to validate and approve your visa.

Once you receive your offer letter, you must pay the fee amount for your 1st year and confirm your position at the university.
